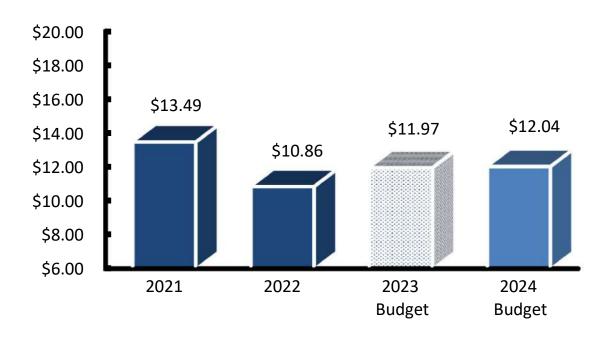

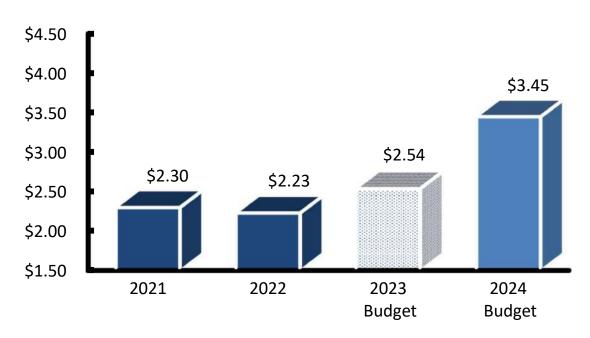

Signatory Passenger Airlines Cost Per Enplanement



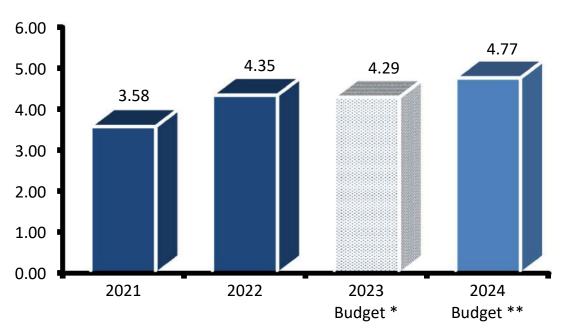
Signatory Airlines Landing Fees (per 1,000 lbs)

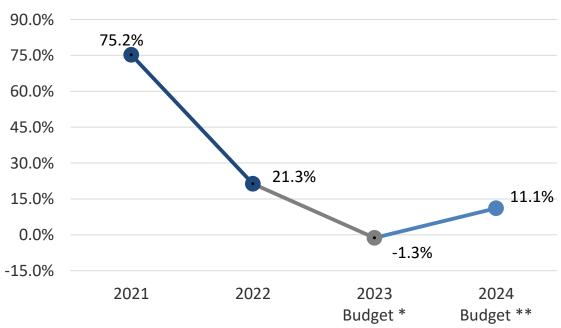
PASSENGER ENPLANEMENT ASSUMPTIONS

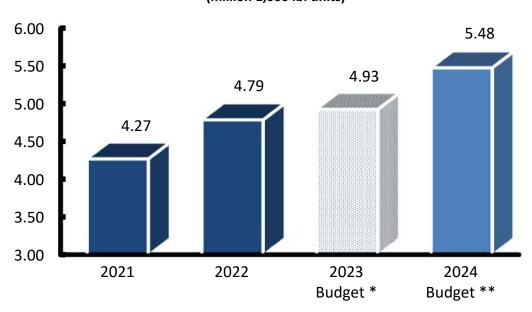

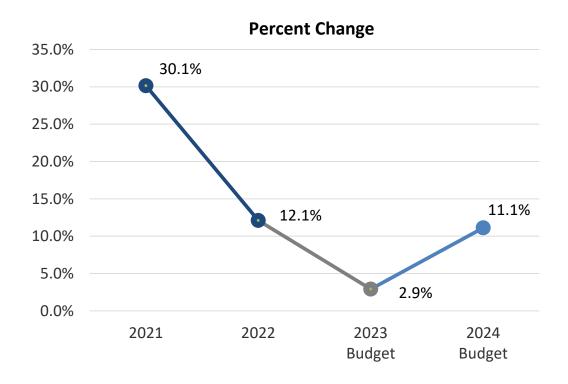
PASSENGER LANDED WEIGHT ASSUMPTIONS

Passenger Carrier Landed Weights (million 1,000 lb. units)



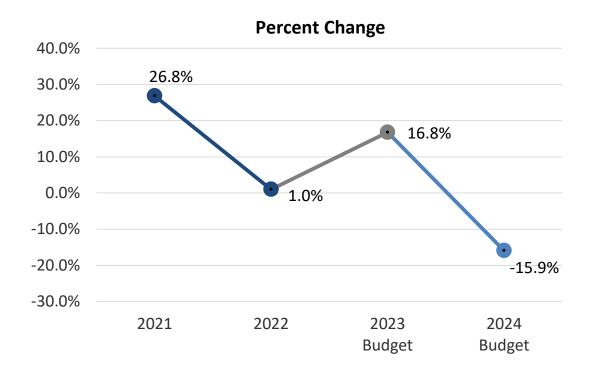

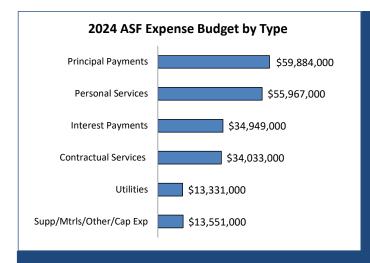


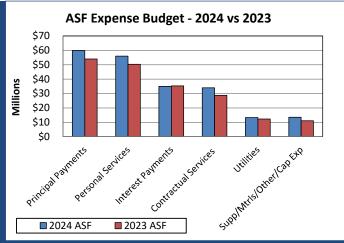
Management Comments

- Airline revenues are planned to increase \$10.3 million (14%) primarily attributable to an increase in landing fee rates (\$3.45 vs \$2.54).
- Retail revenue is anticipated to increase \$4.6 million (23.5%) and parking revenues are planned to increase \$12.9 million (24.5%) assuming 100% recovery of enplaned passengers from 2019 (pre COVID). Additionally, retail minimum annual guarantee commitments are planned at original agreement levels and a continued trend in higher parking product mix is projected (longer stays in garage vs lower parking lot products).
- Passenger Facility Charges are planned to increase \$1.6 million (9.2%) and customer facility charges are planned to increase \$0.5 million (6.3%) assuming 100% recovery of enplaned passengers from 2019 (pre COVID).
- Interest/Other is projected to increase \$5.0 million (83.7%) primarily due to higher earnings planned on securities in the Authority's investment portfolio.

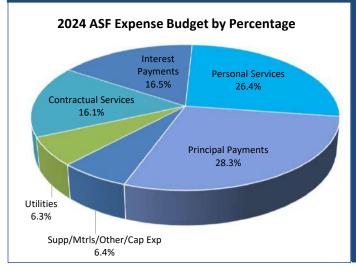

Management Comments

- Personal Services increased \$5.6 million (11.1%) attributable to annual merit and benefit increases and strategic investment staffing increases in support of sustainability, developing talent pipelines and future workforce development needs.
- Contractual Services increase of \$5.3 million (18.4%) includes Environmental and Planning & Development staff augmentation and on-call services, Retail concessions consulting/refurbishment, company-wide training (prepandemic level), projected annual contract increases, various repairs/maintenance cost increases as well as an increase in credit card fees and valet services in line with an increase in projected parking revenues.
- 2024 budgeted debt service represents scheduled interest and principal payments reflecting lower interest and higher principal payments than prior year.
