(Established Pursuant to AIAS Passenger Terminal Lease and Operating Agreement)

The Commissioner of the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF), under authority vested by AS 2.15.020 and Title 17 AAC 42.125, has implemented certain fees listed below for the Alaska International Airport System (AIAS), consisting of the Ted Stevens Anchorage (ANC) and Fairbanks (FAI) International Airports. The rates are effective **July 1, 2015** for AIAS users. Signatory Airlines are air carriers that have executed an AIAS Operating Agreement and Passenger Terminal Lease (Sample Operating Agreement 334 KB and Sample Exhibits to Operating Agreement 4 MB).

The rates are as follows and are subject to change by further public notice:
